Albert is an accomplished dressage instructor. He is a licensed FENA Reitlehrer, holding State and FN Federation National Riding Instructor licenses of the highest degree in Austria. He is proficient in the training and instruction of both horse and rider in Dressage and in the classical art of airs above the ground.

Education:

- Student of the Spanish Riding School in Vienna for 2 years.
- At the age of 18 became the youngest Assistant Trainer in Austria.
- Completed European Degrees as a Bereiter and Reitlehrer.
- Worked with world-renowned trainers George Wahl, Ines von-Badewitz, Ernst Bachinger, Bent Jensen, Jochen Hippenstiel and Arthur Kottas.

Achievements:

- Former Head-trainer for the world famous United States Royal Lipizzaner Stallions.
- Has worked in the largest sales barn in Southern Germany, training and selling sport horses of all levels.
- Holds state and regional titles in Dressage and qualified for the Nationals in California in 1986 and 1987.
- Trained several students for licensing in the field including on currently working assistant to the former Head-Trainer of the Spanish Riding School.
- Has trained several horses through the FEI levels and backed many young prospects.
- Has given numerous clinics throughout the continental United States, Hawaii, and the Netherlands. Currently gives several clinics annually with the Tempel Farms Lipizzaners.
- At Hunt Meadows Farm, trained up to 20 horses and riders for competition with successes, such as several Regional champions.
- Attained Bronze and Silver USDF medals since coming to the United States.

Finally, together with Vanessa Voltzman, a dressage trainer and native of the Netherlands, Albert runs a training facility with their own horses, mostly imported from Europe.
